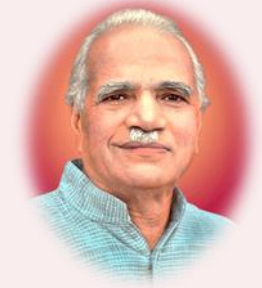

About the Indian Institute of Education:

The Indian Institute of Education was visualised and established in Mumbai (prior known as Bombay) in January 1948 by Shri. J. P. Naik accompanied by R.V. Parulekar and others who initially incepted the institute to be a Research Centre that provided academic opportunities for teachers in Greater Bombay to pursue their post-graduate studies and Doctorate in education. Prof. R.V. Parulekar was the first director of this institution. The institute shifted to Pune in August 1976 to expand its outreach to rural areas by offering inputs in non-formal education and challenging the educational orthodoxy prevailing during that period.

The Indian Institute of Education is dedicated to focus on research in the field of education, but primarily inclining towards interdisciplinary nature in order to establish the relationship between education and development by viewing from various disciplinary perspectives. The Institution is based on two primary mottos and they are;

1. A revolution in life and a revolution in education always go together, because education is life.
2. Education is to be social and humanist, where upliftment of the marginalised remains the prime motif.

The institute has been engaged in the following activities in the past few decades:

- A. Conducting research in the field of education and establishing the relationship between education, society, and development.
- B. To carry out action-based research to find solutions to educational problems based on both, within and beyond formal education and empower the masses through social action.
- C. To conduct National Level research training programmes to nurture young social scientist to develop the skills required for interdisciplinary research through its M. Phil and Ph. D programmes
- D. To plan and organise capacity-building programmes for different stake holders in education to build their capacities for research, development and quality improvement in education.
- E. To develop networks by building platforms for interaction and collaboration such as seminars, conferences, and workshops

The institute has so far collaborated and completed several international and national projects, apart from those at the local levels. The academic faculty has offered expertise to government and non-governmental agencies for improving and strengthening educational systems.

Concept Note:

The National Education Policy-2020 approved by the Union Cabinet of India on July 29th 2020 with the prime objective as to make education more holistic, equitable, and inclusive. It purports to strengthen teacher education, reform the prevailing examination system, strengthen early-childhood care, and restructure the regulatory framework of education. The NEP, 2020 document has already ignited the minds of various stakeholders in education by offering them opportunities to explore and implement this policy for it best. This policy has opened doors for new and innovative approaches to ensure transformations are possible at all levels of school education. Some of the priorities of this policy with regard to school education are curtailing dropout rates and ensuring universal access to education at all levels;

Facilitating learning to be holistic, integrated, enjoying and engaging, enhancing equitable and inclusive educational practices, efficient resourcing, effective governance, improvement of educational quality.

This two-day national seminar shall provide an opportunity to share, interact, sensitize, and inform the participants on ways to strengthen the various elements in school education and visualize the challenges they are likely to face while implementing the principles of this policy. Teachers, students, scholars, educationists, and activists from different areas of expertise shall be able to network and collaborate to ensure the successful implementation of the policy at various level of school education.

Objectives of the Seminar:

1. To facilitate exchange of perspectives on different elements of NEP 2020 and derive its relevance for educational reforms
2. To sensitize the relevance of National Education Policy 2020 for educational transformation and improving school education
3. To discuss the roadmap to social transformation and educational quality
4. To network with different stakeholders for further collaboration and integral initiatives
5. To identify the educational gaps in the prevailing educational systems and recommend strategies to overcome these gaps
6. To ensure successful implementation of NEP 2020 school reforms.
